Paints (tubes or pans)

If you want to be more serious; Cadmium Red Cadmium Yellow One of these or similar: Cadmium Yellow light, Lemon Yellow, Pale Yellow Ultramarine Blue Phthalo Blue Yellow Ochre Burnt Umber. Burnt Sienna Olive Green/Sap Green Purple Crimson Lake/Alizarin crimson Viridian Cobalt Green Cobalt Blue **Compose Blue** Neutral Tint Pavne's Grev White acrylic

Any brand you have is fine. If you're not sure what to buy, I recommended these: Holbein Artist' Watercolor Winsor & Newton Artists' Watercolor Winsor & Newton Cotman Series Jack Richeson & co. (Stephen Quiller Watercolors are excellent products.) M. Graham &Co. (expensive)

Pallet

Paint Brushes I like synthetic brushes, but others are probably fine. Round #10 and #12 or #14 (You do not have to have both 12 and 14) Flat around 3/4 inch wide or wider. 3" flat is convenient to have, but optional.
